Grapevine Art Project Announces Holiday Art Exhibitions

The Grapevine Art Project (GAP) is hosting an art exhibition in the historic Lancaster Theater in Grapevine, based upon this year's theme "Winter Wonderland." All participating members are preparing special art for that theme. The exhibition begins on Wednesday, November 1 and ends on Sunday, December 31. Admission is free, and the artists will have contact information available for subsequent purchase of their art following the exhibition.

This marks several consecutive years that GAP has held a holiday exhibition at the Lancaster Theater. This eight-year old 501 c(3) non-profit organization has also been actively involved in Grapevine's MainStreet Festival and GrapeFest for a number of years. Additional activities are planned for the upcoming year, including new event venues and formats. Some of the GAP events are juried, and others are open for all members to exhibit.

The Grapevine Art Project holds monthly meetings on the second Thursday evening of each month, often featuring presentations and demonstrations from highly regarded artists in many diverse media. Visitors are welcome to attend and learn more about the organization, its members, and programs. Artists include painters, photographers, potters, jewelers, and other media formats. New members, even those who are not artists, are always welcome.
