B.P.D.C Firle Hill Climb Regulations 2019

- 1. Entry to the event is at the sole discretion of the organiser and dependent upon full receipt of the entry fee. More than one car may be entered along with its additional entry fee.
- 2. The entry fee must be with the club no later than 03/07/2019. Failure to do this will forfeit that driver's place in the paddock.
- 3. Once accepted the entry fee is not refundable unless the event is cancelled by the organiser.
- 4. Cars must have been first registered before the end of December 1989.
- 5. Once accepted a car may not be changed without full agreement of the organiser.
- Both car and driver must be fully compliant with UK law and regulation. Upon arrival;
- 7. Entrants should arrive between 07.30 and 08.30 hours on the day.
- 8. All entrants must follow the direction and instruction of the event marshals and organisers.
- 9. Passengers may be carried on the hill climb in accordance with the maximum seating arrangement of that car.
- 10. All drivers must attend the Drivers Briefing to be held in the Driver's Paddock.
- 11. All drivers must park their cars in the Driver's Paddock as directed by the event marshals.
- 12. Cars will be called forward according to the run order as printed in the event running order.
- 13. The paddocks will be open to the public and so drivers must ensure that their cars are left safely and securely.
- 14. The paddock speed limit is 6 mph and the speed limit on Bopeep Lane is 60 mph.
- 15. The event is not a race. Whilst in ascent only one car will be on the route at any given time.
- 16. Drivers deemed to be driving dangerously or at excessive speed will be stopped and required to leave the course.
- 17. In the event of an incident marshals will employ a red flag to stop drivers. The driver will then be advised how best to continue.
- 18. Entrants must ensure that their entered car is in roadworthy condition and capable of completing the hill climb.
- 19. Entrants are responsible for their own personal and/or car insurance.
- 20. The organisers will not accept any claims for damage to any participating vehicle.
- 21. Once over the finish line, drivers must slow their car as quickly as is safe to do so.
- 22. Upon completion of their hill climb the driver and car will wait in the Summit Paddock until directed to descend the hill and return to the paddock.
- 23. Drivers agree to take part in the "Dream ride" option for any person attending the event. Any person may bid and if successful, pay for a ride in their chosen hill climbing car.
