THIS WEEK IN NAVAL HISTORY

31 October 1803- The frigate Philedelphia runs aground near Tripoli while pursuing an enemy vessel in shallow water. As a result, the Tripolitans send a large gunboat force and attack Philedelphia. Stuck fast and listing, she is defenseless and Capt. William Bainbridge surrenders. Under Commodore Edward Prebles's orders Lt. Stephen Decatur leads a mission to burn Philedelphia early the following year.
