CURRENT EVENT OF THE WEEK

In 2012, a new disease by the name of acute flaccid myelitis (AFM) was discovered. This disease results in flaccid paralysis of the muscles of the limbs, neck, face, and often diaphragm and has been called the new polio. The disease is rare but in recent years, it has been taking the lives of more and more. AFM is seasonal, hitting in late summer and early fall, and runs in an "every-other-year cycle" where the number of cases peak in even-numbered years. So far this year, the disease has had several cases across 9 states.
