

A Demonstration by

Paul Fryer

At Shilton Village Hall on Thursday 7th November 2019.

Paul's opening remarks at this meeting was that he would be demonstrating pen turning and finishing with a bit of bowl turning. Now I must admit that when I heard him say "pen turning" I felt a bit disappointed thinking how can anyone hold an audiences attention with pen turning. Most of us have turned a pen at sometime or other and in my case it was always to give as presents to close family and when you have exhausted that you tend to move onto other things and projects.

Well Paul soon had me spellbound by his enthusiasm and the amount of time

and patience he has given to turning some fantastic pens in different woods and other materials as the accompanying pictures will show. Paul did turn a pen but he spent most of the time showing us his methods of producing all manner of decorated pens including segmented, coloured, textured and a host of other designs. Even old clothing (denim) had been incorporated into a pen. Samples were constantly being passed around the audience for their inspection.

Paul had trialled all sorts of ways of doing things connected to pen making and he passed on all his findings to us so that we would not fall into problem areas as he had done along the way.

The second part of Paul's demonstration was given over to bowl turning and for

this he produced a log taken from the trunk of a tree which he had pre-cut in half intending to turn each half into a natural edge bowl, one hollowed from the bark side of the cut log and the other from the sapwood side. This again was interesting and Paul showed his turning skills in doing it, sadly time was not in Paul's favour but we got the idea as to how these bowls would turn out to be on completion.

In conclusion I would like to say that Paul put on a very professional demonstration which was well structured to interest members of all turning capabilities. The tools, jigs, templates and samples he brought along supported his dialogue admirably which you don't always get from





Yes dad said Jimmy but don't worry I will ask Santa for those and you can buy me the cheaper ones


The 36/51 Scout Group in the Workshop


