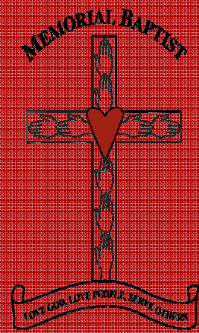

## UPDATE ON PASTOR MIKE

We are still in ICU Trauma, but what a place to share the love of Christ! Mike and I are open to God's plan in this journey! How to pray and praise for and with us:

1. Mike's ketoacidosis is cleared up! Praise the Lord!
2. Mike is very slowly and with much thought putting words together and making sentences! Praise the Lord!
3. Physical Therapy had Mike sitting on his bed, then standing, and then 3 steps to the right, 3 steps to the left, 3 steps forward, 3 steps back . . . repeat. Wore him out and dropped his oxygen, but he did good. Praise the Lord!
4. Continue to read Psalm 91 and any other scripture over us as you pray!
5. Pray for oxygen levels to remain normal with each new physical therapy session.
6. Pray for blood sugars to be managed well in his body throughout the healing of this brain trauma.
7. Pray for rest and renewed strength for both of us.
8. Do not approach any moment of our days casually, but live in Christ alone so others see Jesus in us!

**(7/24)** Mike has been more disoriented this morning due to injury and high BP. Please pray that he can turn off his processing thoughts in order to rest. Pray that his BP will come down to a normal level. Pray for continued healing God's way for him from the top of his head to the soles of his feet.
