As much as 92% of our community is located within High and Very-High Fire Hazard Severity Zones.



- Maintain 100 feet of defensible space around your home.
- Thin trees and limbs, as well as remove ladder fuels to provide firefighters the space they need to defend your home.
- Create a buffer zone by removing fuels that allow fire to climb from the landscape into the tree canopy.
- Common fuel ladders include: tall grasses, shrubs, juvenile trees, and low hanging branches.

ACCEPTABLE ITEMS: Green Waste is biomass consisting of all tree and plant trimmings, dead plants, weeds, leaves, branches, and similar materials that fit into a Green Waste Cart. **Items with a diameter greater than 6 inches, tree stumps and root balls will not be accepted.**
