PathPro Study In China

Overview

PathPro Project is one of the fruits from the fourth round of U.S.-China Consultation on People-to-People Exchange (CPE) co-chaired by Secretary of State John Kerry and Chinese Vice Premier Liu Yandong in 2013. The Project aims at building up sustainable platform for cooperation between Chinese higher vocational colleges and U.S. colleges and universities, especially through enhancing global perspectives for the faculty and students.

As one of the initiatives of PathPro Project, PathPro Study in China is a two-week program offering students from the US opportunities to gain hands-on experiences with Chinese peer students, to walk into emerging industries in China, and to witness the charm of a nation with fast growing economy and fascinating traditional culture.

Contents

Professional courses

Students can attend professional courses in Chinese higher vocational colleges featured with hands-on experiences and assimilated working environment.

Industry exposure

Students will visit the sites and meet with management people of famous enterprises or industry parks. Industries include but are not limited to hospitality, energy, internet, telecommunication, traditional crafts.

City exploration

Students will have chances to explore scenic spots of the cities visited, such as Great wall, Forbidden city, traditional Hutong in Beijing, Olympic sailing base in Qingdao, West lake in Hangzhou, the Bund in Shanghai etc.

Culture experience

Simple Chinese language courses and featured activities like Chinese calligraphy writing, paper-cutting, cooking are available for students to experience the charm of Chinese culture.

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Support

PathPro Project office will provide sponsorship for groups consisting of 10-20 students led by 1-2 faculty members. Our sponsorship will cover the costs for food, lodging, and transportation in China. Interpreter will also be available throughout the program upon request. Students only need to pay for the international flights, visa application, insurance and other personal costs.

Routes can be tailor-made among our 20 Chinese colleges in 13 cities all over China based on the expectations and needs of US institutes. Information of some ready-to-go routes with themes are available for further request.
