February was a BUSY month for us. We went to Lima twice, once for a BIMI Field Conference, and again for youth We had our VBS the week between those trips and had about 90 children in attendance. With contact cards in hand, we are planning a blitz to visit these children and their parents. Many come once a year for VBS and never return. We hope this year will be different.

One of the children that has been coming for a while is Mario. He was saved two weeks after VBS and has been very faithful ever since. He has even started coming to our Sign Language class. This Monday, he brought a friend.

Also, a young couple has returned to Huancayo after nearly ten years of working in the jungle. Jhon works for a company bottling and distributing alcohol. His wife, Jhumey, is a mother of two. They both received Christ last Sunday morning. Their story about how they came back to the Lord is a sweet one. The conviction was evident weeks ago. They finally got it settled. Now, Jhon is convicted about his job. Pray for them. They are looking for an apartment, but they don't want to move far from the church. AMEN!

We are a month away from having our auditorium platform redone! brother from Lima will be coming to put a wooden platform over our cement one. This will add steps across the front, a more comfortable place for an altar call, and a much more presentable look to the front of the church. Our people have raised over \$2,000 for this project. We hope that the completed platform serves to encourage them to look to installing a finished floor in the auditorium. The current floor is a poured concrete. It is cold and difficult to keep clean. Besides, it's about time for a nice floor.



Our family is well. It seems WAY too soon to be considering College for our babies, but by the end of this year, we will be doing just that. Kaitlynn and Alyssa continue their involvement in Sunday School and Junior Church. Savanna is joining them in their accompaniment of the church music on her violin or on the organ. They all rotate piano, violin or flute and organ. I've all but forgotten how to play the accordion. No, not really. But I hardly ever play it now that we have such great sounding music in church. But alas, they are going to leave one by one and leave me without musicians. Sienna will be two in a couple days. We'll start training her right away. Sienna is growing quickly and loves learning new things every day. Stephanie and I trying to stay healthy. Each of us is seeking out individuals in church to disciple on a personal level. At the same time, we will be teaching our disciples how to train others. The church is responding well to our call to action. Many have expressed an interest in discipleship classes, and we are looking to train more and more teachers. One of our greatest desires is for God to send us more young men to train for the ministry. We have two already. Please pray for more.

Our theme this year for our church is taken from Nehemiah 2:18 "Let us rise up and build". We do NOT mean the church building. We would like the platform finished, we would like the \$5,000 floor put in our auditorium, we would like a \$30,000 third floor added. too. But if we got NONE of that accomplished this year, we want to see growth: in our personal and family life, our spiritual maturity, our ministry and our faith.
