Dear Praying Friends,

“I speak with demons. They come to me often and they speak with me. They tell me many things. You know it is very hard to talk with the demons. They are very powerful. Remember me, my name is Nicholas.” As I concluded the Friday open air evening gospel message on the muddy streets of Maweni, I was taken by the hand of a small man who wanted to speak with me. He told me he had been listening to what I had preached, and then began telling me that he needed my help and prayers from demons that have been visiting him for quite some time. I talked with him for a while, shared the gospel with him again, and finally prayed for him. He came to the third evening of preaching and again approached me after the message. He started by telling me that he had forgiven me. I asked him what it was that I had done to offend him, and he replied by saying that I had spoken some stupid words in his ear the other night. I clarified by asking if he was referring to the gospel, and he said yes, that was the problem. I talked with him some more and told him I would be praying for him and that he should begin reading the Bible and look to Christ for saving. I don't know if I will ever see Nic again, but I do pray for his soul, and the souls of the many who heard the gospel over the course of those three nights.

We thank God for the week of evangelistic outreach and teaching at the Mombasa Bible school. We praise the Lord for over twenty professions of faith in Christ. Islam and many other false gospels are being spread throughout Mombasa. The need for the true gospel and Biblical teaching is evident as you speak with the local people. Confusion abounds and the Word of God is hidden in a shroud of religion. As we walked through the different villages near Mombasa, sharing the gospel, we were continually listening to the Muslim Imams as they called from their high spires for the worshippers of Allah to come and pray in the mosque. We probably passed several thousand Muslims in our short stay in Mombasa, and my heart is burdened that each one would have the opportunity to hear the gospel of Christ. Please pray that the grace of God would rain down in this city and others like it.

I was also thankful for the opportunity to spend several days in North Western Kenya in the desert city of Lodwar, with two of our dear missionary friends. It was a blessing to teach and fellowship with a group of pastors who truly love the Lord and are willing to sacrifice so much for the sake of taking the gospel to far away places. Please continue to pray for the other Bible schools here in Kenya and Uganda. Our prayer and desire is to see young men and women trained to continue taking the gospel and biblical teaching throughout East Africa. Living for Eternity,


