I hope all is well as we transition into November! We look forward to a busy month of teaching and learning filled with sweaty brains!

Here are a few important updates for our families, students and school community:

- 1. Boston Schools Fund Good to Great Grant Announcement: On Wednesday, October 31st, I received verbal commitment that the Perry's three-year strategic planning grant has been approved! This grant, over the next 3 years, will have a value of up to \$250,000!! This strategic plan will involve three "Big Rocks" that our Instructional Leadership Team and an outside consultant collaboratively created:
 - Big Rock #1: Increase instructional rigor and standards alignment across all K-8 literacy and STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts, Math) learning experiences.
 - **Big Rock #2:** Develop, communicate and implement a coherent K-8 vision for literacy teaching and learning.
 - Big Rock #3: Build an observation and feedback model for Perry School which develops and coaches instructional leaders to implement observation and feedback.
- 2. **Edvestors School on the Move Finalist:** On Wednesday, October 31st, the Perry was officially recognized as a finalist for being a "School on the Move".
 - As part of this recognition, our school will receive a \$20,000 prize!
- 3. **Attendance Reminders:** We expect to continue to work hard and achieve our school vision by "providing the best education for every child, every day".
 - We will celebrate students with perfect attendance at our Perry Pride Assemblies on Friday, December 7th!
 - We will keeping track of which homeroom has the highest Average Daily Attendance in the month of November. We will announce the winning homeroom on Monday, December 3rd!
 - Please support us to ensure that every student has a 95% or higher attendance rate (9 or less absences for the whole year!)
